1	This congregation has established clear expectations for maturity in discipleship.				
2.	I am an active participant in a small group that includes fellowship, growth, and mission experiences.				
3.	At least once a year, someone from the congregation has a conversation with me about my progress as a disciple.				
4.	Our congregation offers a variety of educational experiences based on the level of maturity as a disciple.				
5.	I have spiritual friends, a mentor, a coach, or a spiritual director who holds me accountable.				
6.	Lay persons are equipped to lead small groups and serve as mentors or coaches for discipleship.				
7.	Worship experiences consistently lead persons to the next step in their discipleship.				
8.	The most mature disciples are encouraged to provide discipling relationships with those new to the faith and leadership for the ministries of the congregation.				
9.	I am involved in serving in the local community, making a difference in people's lives.				
10.	I take responsibility for my own spiritual growth through the daily practices of spiritual disciplines.				
11.	I have relationships beyond the local church through which I am intentionally sharing God's love.				

12.	I give 10% of my income to the ministry of the local church and seek to honor God with the rest.				
13.	I have one or more close friends participating in worship and ministry with me at this church.				
14.	The church has helped me in understanding the Bible and how its teaching applies to my life.				
15.	The leaders of this congregation have such a close walk with Jesus that I am inspired to follow them.				
16.	I really feel like I belong to this community of faith. I am valued, loved, and engaged.				
17.	I am growing in my relationship with Jesus through my connection to this community of faith.				
18.	I have clarity about how God has gifted and called me to serve (made possible through a guided exploration process).				
19.	I live within financial margins in order to bless other people more.				
20.	This congregation helps beginning disciples learn how to pray, read the Bible, and serve.				
21.	Leaders for this congregation are drawn from the most spiritually mature disciples.				
22.	There is training available for this congregation in the building of healthy relationships and sharing faith.				
23.	There is a clear vision of what this congregation hopes for with every disciple engaged in the community of faith.				
24.	While a wide variety of classes are offered, there is also a core curriculum leading people toward the vision for discipleship.				
25.	I am discovering more and more the depths of Jesus' love and longings for me as a disciple.				

Add up the total number of points assigned for each survey. Average the total number of surveys taken. The average is the percentile given by your survey participants (100 points are possible). Using a standard academic scale:

- 90+ = A
- 80-89 = B
- 70-79 = C
- 60-69 = D
