

Worship Survey

A brief survey for leadership teams and/or congregations to provide insight into the level of excellence with which congregational worship is experienced.

(1 = Poor . . . 4 = Amazing)

1.	I attend worship as often as possible, aiming for a minimum of 3 weekends a month.				
2.	The music in worship inspires and lifts my spirit. It is done with excellence.				
3.	I encounter the presence of God in our regular worship services and am inspired to live more fully in the presence of God.				
4.	Our worship services include active participation of the next generations (young adults, youth, and children).				
5.	Worship services are designed to be attractive and engaging for the next generations.				
6.	The worship messages are practical and relevant to my everyday life and encourage me to take next steps in my discipleship journey.				
7.	The worship design enhances my personal worship practices through the introduction of new disciplines and experiences.				
8.	The focus of worship is not disrupted by lengthy stretches of announcements.				
9.	The lessons of Scripture are often presented in creative ways that engage my spirit.				
10.	I leave every worship experience with a clear sense of something I can do to live more fully as a disciple of Jesus Christ.				
11.	I understand the ways in which my offering is making a difference in the community and people's lives.				
12.	Worship experiences are designed in such a way that my senses (sight, sound, touch, smell) are engaged as well as my mind.				
13.	Worship is led by a team including both lay persons and clergy.				

14.	Each worship experience is based on a theme, and every element of worship is designed to bring new levels of understanding.			
15.	The preacher in our worship service shares the message without notes while walking around.			
16.	I regularly feel engaged by the worship experience rather than part of an audience in worship.			
17.	Every worship experience gives me the opportunity to commit more of my life to Jesus.			
18.	The main points of the worship experience are presented so creatively I recall them even weeks later.			
19.	Guests are greeted warmly in worship yet given permission to remain anonymous if desired.			
20.	At some point in each worship experience, I am engaged physically.			
21.	Persons in the congregation make it a point to engage people they don't know in conversation following worship.			
22.	Each worship experience gives clear next steps in my journey as a disciple.			
23.	The design of the worship service provides opportunities to develop new personal spiritual practices.			
24.	Any announcements made during worship provide an opportunity for me to be engaged in the ministry of the congregation.			
25.	Technical support in the worship experience is done with excellence and creativity.			

Add up the total number of points assigned for each survey. Average the total number of surveys taken. The average is the percentile given by your survey participants (100 points are possible). Using a standard academic scale:

90+	=	A
80-89	=	B
70-79	=	C
60-69	=	D
